Mr. Scott Shifrin brings more than 32 years of government service with him, focused on the development and acquisition of Air & Missile Defense programs. Currently, Mr. Shifrin serves as the Interim Director for MDA's Advanced Technology Science & Technology Directorate. Prior to this assignment he spent 3 years as the Program Director for the Missile Defense Agency's (MDA) US-Israeli Cooperative Program to include Arrow-2, Arrow-3, David's Sling Weapon System, and Iron Dome and six years in MDA's Targets and Countermeasures Directorate (TC), the last four years of which as the Deputy Program Director (DPD). In that position, he oversaw and provided strategic direction for a program with an annual budget of over \$400M and

achieved 37 consecutive successful target launches. During his tenure with Strategic Targets, he was responsible for the successful maiden launch and flight of the system in support of the Ballistic Missile Defense System (BMDS). Prior to Mr. Shifrin's civilian career which began with MDA in 2004, he had a distinquished 20 year career in the U.S. Army in combat arms command and acquisition and program management.
